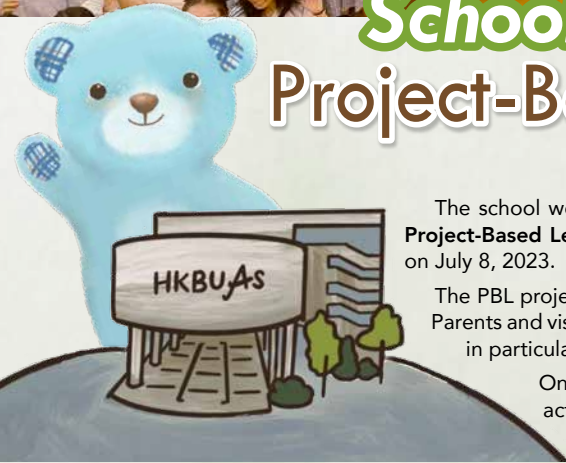

《給孩子們的大師講堂》走進香港校園活動

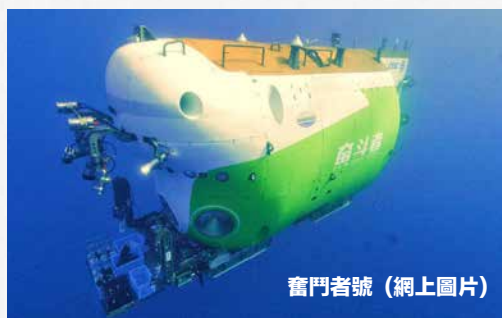
中國「奮鬥者號」潛艦總指揮、總設計師 葉聰先生訪校

該會於9月14日假香港故宮文化博物館賽馬會演講廳舉行交流暨啟動儀式，本校學生亦有幸到場參與，親身向幾位到港分享的中國當代名家學者學習，他們對於能夠與中國的科研、文化、藝術等領域的巨人見面均表示十分興奮，並進一步瞭解國家進步的方向。

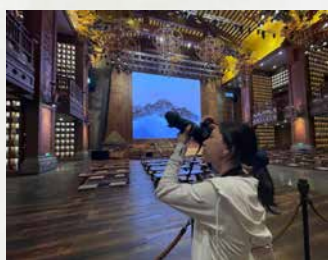

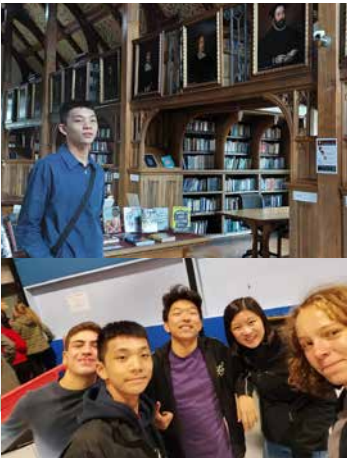
CHEUNG Kwan Chiu

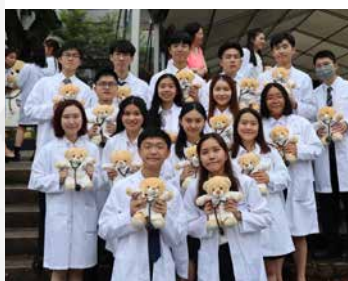
YUEN Wai Ho

June 20-26, 2023

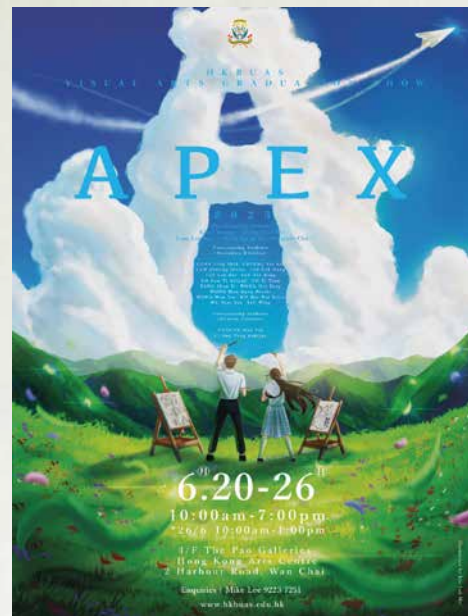

Student Visual Arts Work Aesthete 2023

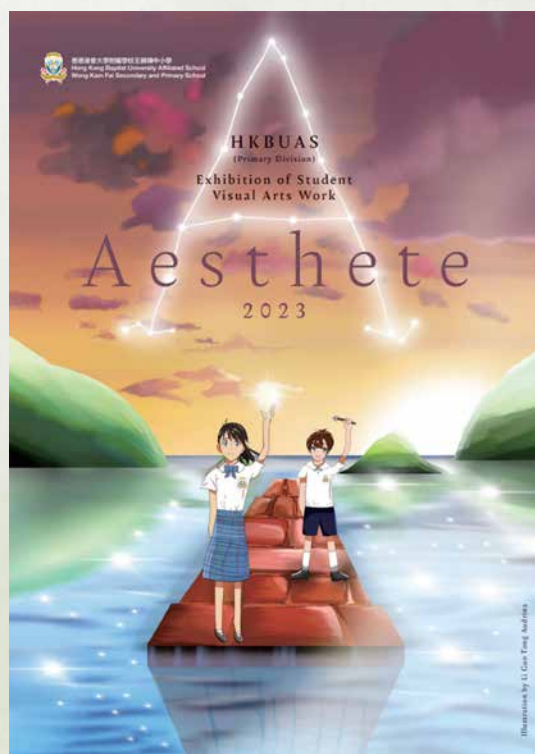
