GCE A-level Global Recognition

GCE A-level is an internationally recognised qualification, adopted in over 125 countries, and is accepted as proof of academic ability for entry to universities worldwide. The syllabuses develop a deep understanding of subject knowledge and independent thinking skills. All the A-level subjects offered are administered by either University of Cambridge International Examinations (CIE) or London Examinations (Edexcel). The A-level is often characterised as a university preparatory course, and most students who choose A-level have an intention of continuing their higher education overseas.

Nonetheless, our GCE A-level students have an equal advantage in applying to local universities through non-JUPAS admission.

Uni Tour transforms this experience into an enriching and enjoyable summer adventure, in which students join campus tours, meet with admissions representatives and collect information about various universities, facilities and study programmes.




Career Immersion

We aim to connect students with employers in the real-world work setting, leading them out of the classrooms in order to expand their knowledge and gain a wider perspective of the industry. Through these immersion experiences, students will be able to know about different careers and understand the expectation from employers, enhance generic skills, and develop workplace etiquette and values which enable them to adapt to society and hence ultimately get well prepared for their careers in life.











Entrepreneurship Inspiration

We aim to shape students into creative and innovative entrepreneurs. We offer workshops and activities which enrich students' life experiences and polish their thinking skills.

A-School has been cooperating with University of Missouri-Kansas City (UMKC) to conduct an entrepreneur programme for students. Through the programme, students will learn about innovation and entrepreneurship, market research, financial analysis, financial valuation, corporate management and other professional skills. They will also learn to create simulation companies in groups by conducting research, roadshows, and other start-up tasks and they have opportunities to communicate with local entrepreneurs and innovation specialists. We continuously keep abreast of new trends to expand student's learning opportunities, enhance students' competitiveness and promote whole-person development.

Admission Coaching

We aim to help students define their educational goals, make informed decisions, maximise their options and prepare for admission to prestige universities around the globe.

We adopt the Three A's Model (Application, Admission & Acceptance) to provide support for students at different stages based on their needs and ambitions. Further professional support is also available to outstanding students in applying to top notch universities in the world.

THREE A's Model

Stage 1 Application We provide students with an overview of further studies in local and overseas institutions, highlight important notes in making successful applications as well as prepare students to make suitable programme choices. Seminars and workshops will be arranged to all senior students by Further Studies Team. Heads-up sessions will also be arranged through Collegelink to keep students posted of upcoming events.

Stage 2 Admission We let students go through the details of different admission requirements, and guide them to make a successful application. We encourage students to aim high and broad with holistic planning.

Individualised consultation by our Further Studies Team teachers and our Senior Consultant in Further Studies are available to offer advice according to students' individual needs.

Stage 3 Acceptance We maximise students' chances of acceptance by providing individual special trainings, such as personal statement and interview preparation workshops, admission test courses, and more. Potential runners for top-notch universities, including University of Oxford, University of Cambridge, Imperial College London, Massachusetts Institute of Technology, will be offered exceptional trainings for their acceptance.

Principal Nomination -High School Recommendation Admission Scheme

HKBUAS is the pioneer to forge a partnership with Waseda University (WU), an acclaimed and long-established top private university in Japan, to launch the High School Recommendation Admission Scheme. Two students from our school are eligible to be nominated to the university's School of International Liberal Studies each year, with a scholarship to support their learning overseas. Other students from our school interested in applying for the designated programme will enjoy bonus points given by the university in recognition of the outstanding performance of our graduates in WU.





Founded in 1882, WU is one of the most prestigious private universities in Japan, and is consistently positioned among the top institutions in Japan university ranking. WU has been a cradle of many notable public figures, including Prime Ministers, literary giants and CEOs of international enterprises.



University of Missouri-Kansas City High School Dual Credit Programme

HKBUAS is the first and only local school to develop a partnership with the University of Missouri-Kansas City (UMKC) in offering a Dual Credit Programme for our students who are interested in pursuing STEM-related programmes in the future. We are the first school in Hong Kong to be officially recognised as the UMKC STEM Learning Hub. Our students can experience various learning activities, meet with scholars, participate in lectures, conferences and symposia.

Students enrolled in the dual credit courses can earn college credits at A-School and transfer the earned credits to most public and private colleges and universities in the US, upon receiving institutions' approval.

Many talented graduates from our school have received offers of admission to SCAD's prestigious programmes to pursue their dreams in Art and Design.

Students with outstanding performance in Art and Design could be nominated by the school principal for admission to SCAD with scholarships. One of our alumni, a student of SCAD, was recently selected an Oscar finalist out of nearly 2,500 entries worldwide for the prestigious 50th Student Academy Awards and her film also won Film of the Year at the Rookie Awards 2023!









Ontario High School Diploma

Ontario High School Diploma is the province's official high school diploma offered by Ontario Minister of Education, Canada. It is well-recognised by universities around the world for direct admission.

HKBUAS has partnered with a Virtual High School in Canada, which is authorised to grant credits for the Ontario Secondary School Diploma. Students will study a dual curriculum in Grades 9-12 in A-School, followed by a self-financed online top-up programme with the Virtual High School in Grades 11-12 to gain the qualification.


