Our Strengths

- Our school is affiliated with the Hong Kong Baptist University, one of the most reputable universities in the region.

Our Weaknesses

- Teachers' turnover has led to greater need for coaching and team building.
- Diversity of students' needs and abilities remains a challenge for teachers.

Our Opportunities

- The growing number of graduates in different areas of expertise will bring in more resources and contributions.
- Our expanding partnership with other educational institutions such as overseas universities and the HK Academy for Gifted Education will create a wider range of learning opportunities for our students.
- The optimization of the HKDSE core subjects will release space to cater for students' diverse learning and development needs.

Our Threats

- Students' dropout rate has been less stable as more parents consider sending their children to study overseas.
- The 15% quota on student intake from the Shatin district limits the flexibility of our admissions.
- The epidemic has brought us challenges in sustaining students' learning motivation, resilience and commitment to the school.
