





### The Story of Planet Earth



## 《酒徒》

《酒徒》的故事圍繞着一個渴望成為嚴肅文學作家的文人。由於他的 理想難以在戰後的香港實踐,這文人只好寫低俗小說為生,更成為了酒徒。 這本書顛覆了小說原有的寫實模式,作者以優美的文句,帶出故事的含義, 內容反映現實,發人深思。

首先,作者用意識流的手法,以第一人稱「我」的內心獨白來交代故事的來龍去脈。意識流有兩個好處:第一,使情節鋪排得更流暢和自然;第二,透過意識流描繪主角的言行舉止和心理活動,突出他的性格形象。以第二章為例,作者通過描寫酒徒在腦海中構思故事和評論著名小說,顯出他有深厚的文學修養。本書不僅記錄事情,也描寫了人的思想,意識流正反映「我」潛藏心中的想法和體會一現實是殘酷的。酒徒酒醉或在夢中時,總會浮現怪誕、荒謬、扭曲的畫面,揭發現實中的狂亂和社會的黑暗。在第二十五章,作者記述酒徒醉酒時夢見文學和藝術在香港成為禁品,文人的創作自由被剝削,這場夢彰顯了主角和當代文人的恐懼,也批判了香港是文化沙漠的現象。

除了意識流手法外,小說與詩歌的結合也值得一談。作者經常以新詩表達酒徒的夢境,鮮明的節奏和意象獨具匠心。第二章的詩講述酒徒夢見自己中了馬票,並將鈔票擲在別人的臉上。鈔票代表酒徒夢寐以求的金錢與地位,反映他所渴望的遙不可及。富有意義的詩,使讀者留下深刻印象。




《酒徒》一書多次提及「酒」,它看似是平平無奇的配角,卻是小說中的重要象徵。本書反映出赤裸的現實:任何人都可自主地選擇人生要走的路,但我們的選擇卻有限,而選擇會帶來各種後果。「我」有創作嚴肅文學作品的選擇,然而這做法不能維持生計,難道「我」可以不顧一切地選擇追求夢想嗎?因此「我」被迫寫武俠、色情等「文學垃圾」來賺錢。當人沒有身份、地位或資源,就只能被社會局限着人生。因此,「酒」象徵着酒徒迫於無奈的選擇一逃避現實。酒徒曾說:「酒是一種護照,常常帶領我走到另一世界。」他受到現實殘酷打擊後,只好舉杯消愁,忘卻痛苦。

《酒徒》以與眾不同的寫作手法顛覆一般小說的秩序,作者 從塑造角色形象,到突顯現實的殘忍和苦惱,都做得卓有成效。 大約六十年前發表的作品,至今依然能夠震撼讀者,令人回味不 已。

## 《孤獨是種大自在》

人總是害怕孤獨,排斥孤獨。《孤獨是種大自在》告訴我的》,是孤獨並非甚麼妖魔鬼怪,而是給予自己一個獨處的環境及自在的心態。

「世人在提到「孤獨」一詞時,往往帶着同情和憐惜,如同霧裡看花,根本謬解了當事人的心境。」本書劈頭就提及這一真理。現今的人總是把孤獨歸納為「頹廢」,恨不得分分秒秒都和他人相處。可是,他們忽略了人類需要一個獨處的空間以梳理自我,休養生息。也許當你在同情別人孤單時,那人卻對於和自己獨處的空間感到無比愉悅。孤獨時,人更能顯露孤獨的美。李白的名作《月下獨酌》提及他獨自在月下飲酒,卻由於高逸的詩思,能把明月和影子招呼來一起飲酒,天人合一、物我相忘的心情表露無遺。短短一首詩,已說出孤獨藝術的最高境界。顯然,孤獨在美感和詩歌裏有一定的價值,在現實生活中也有它的意義。

在《寂寞的藝術》一文中,林清玄提及「不鳴則已,一鳴驚人」。表面上是讚揚「一鳴」的驚人,實質上卻在闡釋沉默的「不鳴」所蘊含的深意。表面而感人的成就固然可喜,隱在其後的沉默之努力更是可貴。沉默不是不懂與人相處,而是一種藝術觀照文學哲學中的精神,沉默是最重要的。「致於中而發於外」只有最堅實的沉默後,才有最偉大的作品。在生活當中,沉默為高,浮躁為低,通過無數與人相處的經驗後,我們才領悟這個道理。朋友因沉默而心靈相通,多說則無益。聽人說太多話必然會令人感到煩躁,甚至煩厭。當朋友沉默時,一切都在共享。不用言語,一切思想,一切希冀,都在無聲的喜樂中發生共享。心有靈犀,無形中顯揚了沉默。保持適當的沉默,實在是一種修養和藝術。

縱觀現實生活,許多人誇誇其談,不斷做「出位」的行動, 其實便是希望有人能夠關注他們。正所謂「是金子的總會發光」 適當地沉默及孤獨能夠沉澱自我,正視自己的不足。那好比一面 清明的鏡子,不論好惡,都會顯出清楚明確的樣貌。人類藉此反 省並改善,從容地生活,自身也會因而散發奪目的光澤。一個人 内在狀態又好比水。水可以用任何狀態存在於世界,可以包容一 切,也可以被一切包容。如水的心也要保持在清淨的狀態下才能 有益,若化為大洪、巨瀑、狂浪,則會在洶湧中迷失自我。自我 修養的重要性就在於保持自我,不因現實的寒冷、人生的熱惱、 生活的流動而忘失自我的温暖與清淨。

現代社會,我們無法避免與人交流。孤獨與沉默恰到好處就是我們需要的東西。正如紀伯倫所說:「你和朋友分手時,不要悲傷,因為你最愛的那些美質,他離開你時,你會覺得更明顯,就好像爬山的人在平地上遙望高山,那山顯得更清晰。」孤獨不僅是人的內在,更使人改善自身。學會擁抱孤獨,與自己相處,成為更好的人。



# English Reading Report

## One of us is lying Leung Sin Tung Ruby 10C

One of us is lying is a mystery novel written by Karen M. McManus and published in 2017. The story starts off when five students, Bronwyn, Cooper, Nate, Addy and Simon, are having detention after a teacher found phones in their bags, which is against the school rules. The students are distracted by a car accident outside the classroom window. After a minute, Simon suffers from an allergic reaction and dies after drinking water from a plastic cup, and right before he could post the deepest secrets of the other four students on his gossip app. The four students become suspects for murdering Simon. As the police further investigates, the four of them build a close bond with each other while digging out the truth themselves.

The book touches on subjects like school bullying, gender identities, depression, and gives readers topics of discussion. The author also writes about the struggles one will encounter during adolescence in the story plot, which makes young readers easy to relate themselves to.

Other than that, the story is full of suspense. The plot is hard to predict, and I was a bit surprised as the truth of Simon's death unravelled. The mysterious vibe of the plot made me crave for more and I was unable to put the book down. The book is divided into chapters written from the point of view of each of the four suspects. The author showcases the individuality and the personalities of each one very well.

All in all, *One of us is lying* has an exciting plot which conveys meaningful messages. I would recommend it to my friends.

## Macbeth KEUNG Tsz Shing, Fernando 10E

Macbeth, among Shakespeare's numerous plays, stands out as one of his shortest tragedies. Shakespeare's wonderful craft of the characters' development and acts of bloodshed blotted throughout the play tells the audience of the negative consequences ambition and power can bring.

"All hail, Macbeth, that shalt be king hereafter!"


Macbeth first begins his treacherous journey with a prophecy by the three witches and starts to brew his murder plan with Lady Macbeth, and to stuff his moral value into the abyss as he schemes the regicide plot.

Lady Macbeth can be seen even more ambitious than the Thane of Cawdor himself, encouraging Macbeth to ignore his moral values and put power and status above all else, which he does and becomes king- or so they thought.

"Is this a dagger which I see before me, the handle toward my hand? Come, let me clutch thee."

After Macbeth kills the king, the oldest son, Malcolm, flees the country and plots revenge. Eventually, he reclaims the throne and Macbeth meets his end, along with Macduff, a thane who is also against Macbeth.

# English Reading Report

The language and structure of the characters' lines are confusing to many, if not all, of the readers. Reading without any historical context and a book of annotations proves to be impossible to modern English speakers. We are not accustomed to Shakespeare's iambic pentameters, rhyming couplets or blank verse. Though with some deeper understanding and "treasure hunting", the language suddenly seems integral to how the play is so captivating. It is used to convey a sense of time and place for the audience and to describe the setting, sound effect, and atmosphere. It also signals the characters' entrances and exits, along with actions that happened offstage, which cannot be shown effectively with the technology of Shakespeare's time.

"By the pricking of my thumbs, something wicked this way comes."

This play is a classic, and I would highly recommend it to anyone who would love to delve into Shakespeare's plays and elaborate designs - that is, if they are up to the challenge of reading old English.


